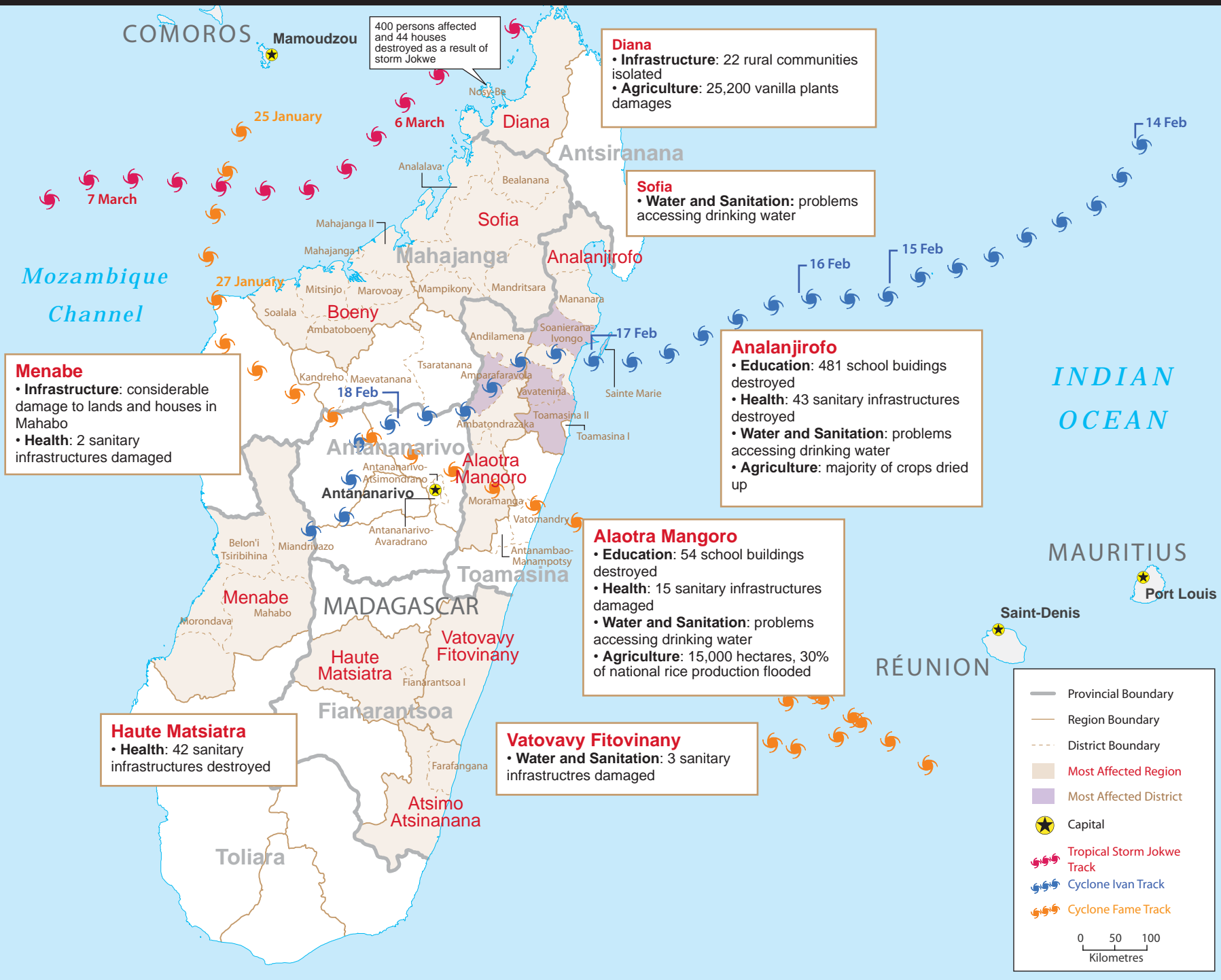


# Madagascar: Cyclones (as of 10 Mar 2008)



## SITUATION

- Tropical cyclone Ivan struck Madagascar on Sunday 17 February, 2008 at wind speeds more than 200 km per hour affecting 14 regions and 44 districts.
- Tropical storm Jokwe entered the bay of Ambodivahibe on Wednesday 5 March 2008 around midnight causing further damage
- Assessments on damage are still ongoing; numbers expected to rise in coming weeks
- Water levels have decreased in the capital and most families have returned to their homes
