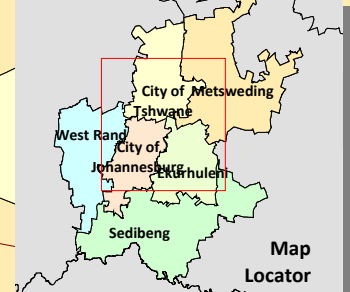
RIVER ROAD

- Need clarity on how they will reclaim their goods
- Zimbabwean and Mozambican waiting for buses to go home

- 397 tents

- DWB in the afternoon
- Diabetics / TB
- No children going to school

- More admin capacity
- ID cards
- Showers
- Baby goods
- More tents
- Cooking areas
- Prefab
- Medical aid kit
- Crèche
- Waste and grey water
- Hygiene training

DBSA (300)

RAND AIRPORT

Current Situation

- 300 tents
- +/- 1,800 people
- 24hr security
- DWB Clinic
- Children attending school
- Registered so far 900 people for ID

Needs

- Warm showers
- Defined policy on taking in more people
- ID cards
- Office / Admin space
- Crèche
- Waste and grey water
- Hygiene training

DBSA

Current Situation

- 69 tents
- +/- 300 people
- Red Cross in full support at Shelter
- DWB on the week end
- Health Dept. on site 5 days per week

Needs

- Showers
- ID cards
- Transportation for children to school
- Separation tent for women's bathing area
- Dustbins
- Waste and grey water
- Hygiene training

WADEVILLE

Current Situation

- 230 tents
- 918 people

- 3 security horses

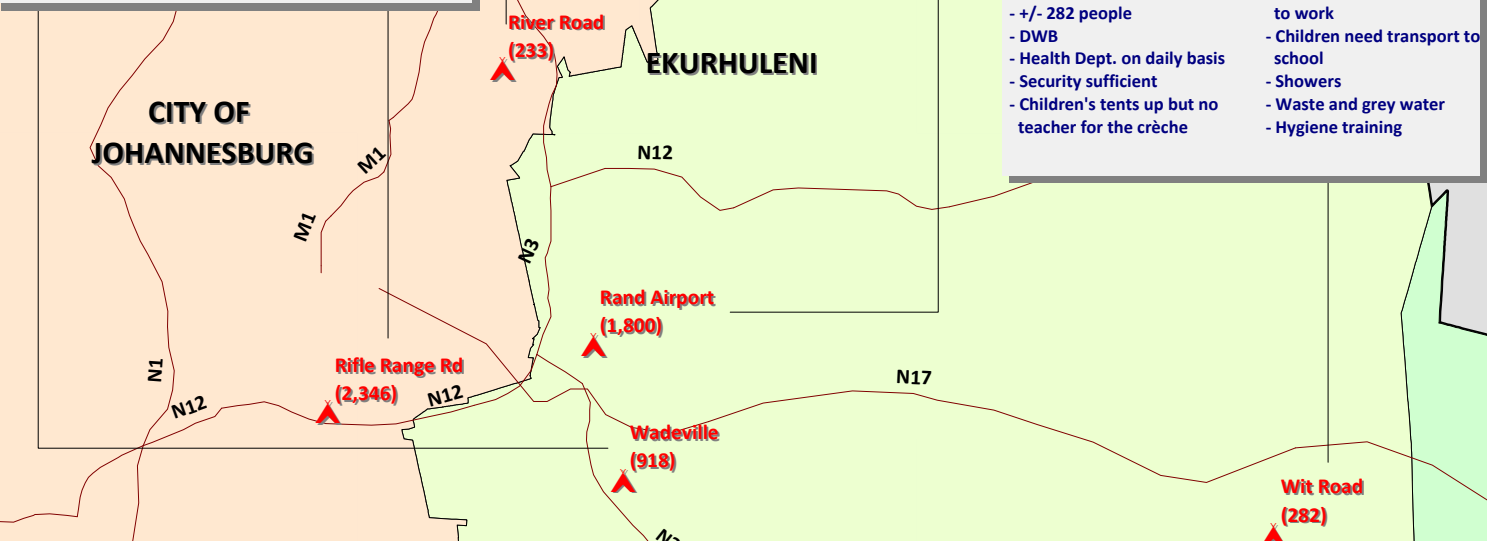
Needs

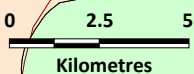
WIT ROAD
