Political and other developments

- Al-Bashir announces national reconciliation on Abyei, pledges to spread security. Salva Kiir urges Darfur armed groups to opt for peace, calls for resumption of Khartoum – N'djamena's ties (Al-Sahafa)
- CPA partners reach final agreement on Abyei (Sudan Vision)

Protection and Human Rights

- Six hundred detainees against Omdurman incidents background freed (Sout Al-Umma)
- Agwai charges Darfur Armed Movements with recurring attacks (Al-Sahafa)
- Attacks on IDPs in Southern Kordofan (Khartoum Monitor)
- Khartoum demolishes more than 350 houses in Mayo IDP camp (Sudan Tribune)

Governance and rule of Law

- 14 amendments to Police Act proposed – National Democratic alliance (NDA) calls for scratching article 14 and restricting police immunity (Akhir LaHZHa)

- GoSS apprehends 11 accused of looting in Juba, reiterates continuation of disarmament via three stages (Ajras Al-Horyah)
