Political and other developments

- [Report] Refugee Commissioner Al-Aghbash – refugees and dream of return. Situation now ripe for voluntary return after Naivasha. Commission in bad need of funds to assess number of refugees abroad. NGOs present relief in kind, biggest burden lies on Refugee Commission's shoulder (Al-Gwat Al-Muslaha)
