

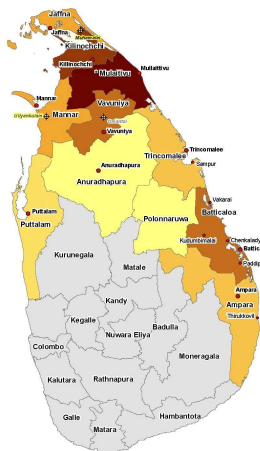

JAFFNA DISTRICT

Situation update

- The security situation in the Jaffna peninsula remained tense during the week, especially in areas around the FDL due to confrontations and artillery shelling. Roads continue to be regularly blocked in order to allow military convoy movements.
- Fuel shortages experienced by the Ceylon Transport Board continue to impact public transport services.
- Despite the Ceylon Electricity Board's indication of improved power supply, power cuts continue outside the city including some divisions in Valihmamam, which are experiencing cuts of longer durations.
- The Government Agent reports sufficient quantities of cement in the district but cautioned the public to avoid over purchase.
- With the recently arrived monsoon rains, farmers have started paddy cultivation.

Displacement/Returns

- No reported displacement or returns took place this week.

KILINCHCHI & MULLAITHIVU DISTRICTS

Situation update

- Reportedly, artillery shelling continues in areas close to Kilinochchi town and town residents have displaced towards the eastern part of the district along the A35 road.
- Seasonal rains have started in Vanni, particularly affecting IDPs in temporary arrangements. According to the District Secretariat of Kilinochchi, thousands of IDPs families are still in need of emergency shelter. With the assistance of local NGOs, 32 IDP families have been shifted to safer locations following the rains affecting the Neththaliyaru site, a lowland area of Tharmapuram village in Kandawalai division.
- 190,000 liters of kerosene from the September fuel allocation were delivered by MPCSSs, representing less than half of the allocation. Similarly, from the October fuel allocation, 75,400 liters of kerosene was transported, which was substantially less than the earlier approved allocation. A liter of kerosene sells for 350 rupees, while MPCSSs are distributing one liter of kerosene per family per month for 90 rupees.

- UN staff, which accompanied the UN Convoy on 17 October, identified the following key needs. In addition to the regular supply of food aid, there are urgent requirements in shelter and sanitation, particularly as the Monsoon rains intensify. Additional information is needed on the impact of abandoned agricultural lands on longer term food security. The education system is functioning but temporary learning spaces and associated water and sanitation facilities are required to accommodate the large additional caseload of displaced students. Peoples' coping mechanisms appear to remain in tact presently, and Government and community structures seem to be functioning well though with constraints in terms of capacity and material. However, people are increasingly vulnerable because of their reduced purchasing power and health risks associated with heavy rains, poor sanitation and decrease in the capacity of health services.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- Following urgent repairs on a culvert between Nadukeny and Oddusudan on the route used to bring supplies into the Vanni, a GA convoy of 28 lorries carrying 271MT of flour, sugar, dhal, oil and kerosene was sent to the Vanni on 16 October 2008. From 02 October 2008 to date, the Government convoys to the Vanni have provided a total of 714MT of food including flour, dhal, sugar and oil with another 168,399 liters of kerosene.
- The WFP food convoy scheduled to enter the Vanni on 16 October turned back due to military activity close to the A9. The convoy proceeded the following day, with 50 trucks and 9 support vehicles carrying 736 MT of food. The assistance will cover basic food needs of approximately 217,000 people for seven days.
- On 22 October, RDHS of Kilinochchi reported 12 cases of malaria (9 from Kilinochchi district and 3 from Mullaitivu district). All patients are IDPs and have been displaced from Mannar and Aaliyavalai in Vadamarachchi East. RDHS offices have arranged awareness programmes at IDP sites including public service announcements.
- RDHS is waiting arrival of essential drug supplies for the fourth quarter of 2008.
- On 21 October, an assessment was conducted at the Ramanathapuram East Government School in the Vaddakkachchi area where the Madhu zone schools and 5 other schools have been functioning. The number of students attending classes has increased sharply from 700 to 2,500. Temporary learning spaces as well as sanitation facilities were identified as urgent priorities. GA Kilinochchi is preparing to provide 25 tarpaulins for temporary class rooms. Construction of temporary learning Spaces (TLS) has started in Oddusuddan, Katchilaimadhu, Muththayankattu and Karudamadhu in Mullaitivu district in order to address the increased numbers of displaced students in these areas.

MANNAR & VAVUNIYA DISTRICTS

Situation update

- The general situation in Vavuniya and Mannar District remains tense and potentially volatile. Security forces remain on high alert throughout both districts with ongoing cordon and search operations.
- Restrictive procedures at Medawachchiya and at checkpoints along A14 road continue.

Displacement>Returns

- There are no changes to the number of displaced people living in Mannar district. The number of IDPs at Sirukkandal stands at 119 families (265 individuals), whereas at Kalimodda 217 families (497 individuals) are being accommodated.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- RDHS with support from UNICEF undertook a district level resource mapping exercise for Health and Nutrition in order to have a better picture of actors and resources in Vavuniya district.
- A Common Humanitarian Action Plan (CHAP) workshop was held in Anudharapura on 15 October to discuss the current humanitarian situation and priorities for emergency response in 2009.

TRINCOMALEE DISTRICT

Situation update

- The security situation in Trincomalee District remains relatively stable but with a number of incidents reported in the outskirts of Trincomalee town and at areas bordering Mulattivu and Welioya. Security forces throughout the district are on high alert and are conducting cordon and search operations in Trincomalee town and surrounding areas.

Displacement/Returns

- On 15 October, 59 families (151 persons) returned to Chenaiyoor and one family (5 persons) to Kaddaiparichan South, Muttur DS division from Kiliveddy transit site. On 16 October, at least 69 families were scheduled to return from Batticaloa district to Chenaiyoor.
- Spontaneous returns to the new resettlement areas in Muttur East are reportedly occurring on a daily basis. IDPs who have been staying with host families in Trincomalee district are required to register at the Killiveddi camp before onward movement to the return areas. Some IDPs from Batticaloa are also moving to the Kiliveddy transit site before being transferred to their previous home locations in Muttur East.
- On 14 October, 39 people (19 male/ 20 female) from Mulliwaikkal, Mullativu arrived via the sea in Pulmuddai. They were picked-up by the SLA and transferred to facilities in Mannar.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- The water scarcity in Kiliveddi transit site and resettlement areas was resolved after the Irrigation Department opened the upstream gates of the Kiliveddy River.
- During the weekly shelter meeting, ZOA reported that 41 shelters in Nalloor will be completed next week. Subsequently, the government authorities will resettle 20 families from Nalloor on 20 October.
- On 13 October UNHCR, OfERR, PIN, ZOA and UMCOR conducted a joint shelter/repair needs assessment in Kaddaiparichan South. It was agreed that UMCOR and UNHCR-OfERR will carry out repairs in Kaddaiparichan, while UNHCR-OfERR will cover Santhanoveddai and Ganeshapuram. The repair of damaged houses in Chenaiyoor will be done by UMCOR/PIN/UNHCR-OfERR. NRC will construct core shelters in Kaddaiparichan and Chenaiyoor and IOM will cover Santhanovaddai and Ganeshapuram.

BATTICALOA DISTRICT

Situation Update

- A number of security incidents occurred over the week including attacks on security forces and TMVP members, cordon and search operations and arrests.

Displacement/Returns

- According to Government statistics of 16 October, there are 11,463 IDPs (2,975 IDP families) in Batticaloa District. During 2008, 25 Government organized return movements have supported returns for nearly 14,000 IDPs within the district and to Trincomalee.
- On 10 October, a total of 654 IDPs (162 families) returned to Veppaveduwan and Periyapullumalai in Chenkalady DS divisions. All returnees received UNHCR tarpaulin kits, a Government return package, and additional NFRIs from UNHCR and ICRC. On 10 October, 25% of remaining IDPs (122 individuals/44 families) opted to return to Periyapullumalai.
- On 10 October, 55 families (152 individuals) from Koppavely in Chenkalady DS divisions arrived at the transit site to register as returnees. These families were displaced prior to the Ceasefire Agreement and had already benefited from return assistance, but never physically returned.
- The Government planned a return movement to Chenaiyoor in Muttur on 16 October for 69 families (214 individuals). Another return to Chennaiyoor is anticipated for the following week and additional returns within Batticaloa and to Trincomalee are expected for late October/early November.

- UNHCR and local authorities have initiated consultations with IDPs on consolidation of the 17 official IDP sites, including the decommissioning of sites expected to be affected by floods during the approaching rainy season. Consolidation is proposed to begin with IDPs from five camp sites to reduce the number of sites to 12.

Sector Development/Gaps

- An Inter-Agency needs assessment mission with wide UN and NGO participation, facilitated by UNHCR took place to Vadamunai, Uthuchani, Muruthanai and Koraveli return areas in Kiran, with the objective of identifying priority reintegration needs. Findings indicate that support is needed in the areas of shelter as well as improved access to drinking water, health services, education and livelihoods. Inside Kiran, no health centers are operating and most schools are in a state of disrepair. Water and sanitation coverage is improving, after UNICEF organized water trucking through local authorities to all Kiran return areas and well cleaning and well construction has started. Emergency schools have been erected in several return areas, and school kits and furniture distributed with UNICEF support. UNICEF and the education department have agreed on reconstruction of priority schools. UNDP/ILO continues work on the jointly developed UN initiative in Thikiliveddai and Punanai West, mainly in the livelihood and housing sectors. A number of NGOs, including ZOA, OXFAM and NRC, have also stepped up reintegration projects in new return areas and ICRC is providing paddy seeds in Kiran. Twelve UNHCR/Solidar quick impact projects (QIPs) have reached the completion stage, mainly agricultural projects such as home gardens, organic farming, but also bridge/ culvert repair. Implementation of an additional six UNHCR/Solidar QIPs has started. Five new QIPs will be implemented in Kiran/Chenkalady return areas; one of it supporting the newly constructed Batticaloa market.
- Shelter assistance is ongoing for almost 6,000 returnees in Koraveli (NRC/HELP), Vadamunai (UNHCR/UNOPS), Uthuchenai (UNHCR/UNOPS), Veppavaduwan (IOM), Periyapullumulai (ICRC), and Thikiliveddai (HELP).
- Upon the request of the Agrarian Service Department and farmer organization of Koraveli in Kiran DS division, Oxfam GB is renovating the irrigation tank 'Sothayan Kulam (Tank) in Koraveli to support farmers in their cultivation. The project is funded by Oxfam GB to ESCO and implemented through Farmer organizations in the area. Nearly 85-90 % of the work has been completed. With the renovation of the tank, 150 acres of land is expected to be cultivated. Tank maintenance will be undertaken by the farmer organization funded by Oxfam GB.
- WHO undertook a mission during the first week of October to assess health care services in resettlement areas in Batticaloa. The mission team included WHO, UNHCR and CAM and visited 7 resettled areas in Kiran and Chenkalady DS divisions and had discussions with RDHS and UNICEF to agree on health care coverage for Chenkalady and Kiran return areas. The field mission report with findings, health issues, recommendations etc was shared with relevant agencies for further action.
- WFP allocated 8,000 agricultural tools for resettled areas in Batticaloa district. WFP and FAO through Government partnerships started the distribution of paddy seeds and agriculture tools to 500 farmers in the Kiran resettled area.
- WFP provided 5 MT mixed commodities to 800 IDPs in camps in Chenkalady DS division.

AMPARA DISTRICT

Situation Update

- The security situation in Ampara is generally stable, with ongoing tension and operations in Kanchikudichiaru.
- On 13 October, Eastern University students demonstrated to have the Police post established within the University premises shifted.

Displacement>Returns

- 17 September IDP Statistics from the Office of the Ampara Government indicate 4,223 persons (1,148 IDP families) of whom, 829 persons (221 families) are from Trincomalee District, 2,927 persons (816 families) are displaced within the district, and the remaining 467 are displaced from Batticaloa (271), Jaffna (61), Vavuniya (35), Kilinochchi (24) and Mannar (76). More than 95% of the displaced persons are living with friends and relatives.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- No significant developments.
