

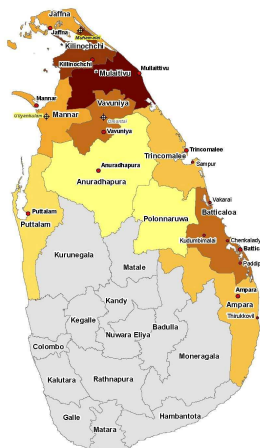

JAFFNA DISTRICT

Situation update

- The general security situation in the Jaffna peninsula remained tense during the week, especially in areas around the FDL. The SLA and Navy have increased checks on vehicles and personnel in the mainland and islets. Cordon and search operations especially in Thennamarachchi areas have increased. Roads continue to be blocked to allow military convoy movements.
- The passenger ship operating between Kankasanthurai and Trincomalee has suspended its service for maintenance until 02 November.

MANNAR, VAVUNIYA, KILINOCCHI & MULLAITHIVU DISTRICTS

Situation update

- Aerial bombardments and heavy shelling have been reported over the past week as fighting refocused on the areas around Kilinochchi town.
- There have been no seasonal rains in the Vanni over the past week giving respite for the estimated 20,000 families in most urgent need of shelter assistance. Thousands of IDP families are still taking shelter under tarpaulin sheets in IDP sites in the Vanni.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- The office of the RDHS-Kilinochchi reported that two lorry loads of the Ministry of Health drug allocation which makes up the third quarter allocation (including badly needed anti-snake venom) was transported to the Vanni from Vavuniya last week while the third quarter allocation for Mullaitivu is awaited.
- The RDHS-Kilinochchi opened a ward at the Thamapuram health facility (hospital). An average of 900 patients visit the Out Patient Department daily and 300 patients are currently in the ward.
- The GA of Kilinochchi reported on 29 October that WFP's dry ration distribution is continuing through MPCS outlets for 38,763 families (148,109 individuals) in Kilinochchi district. ZOA and World Vision were able to transport two truckloads of complimentary food items into the Vanni last week, which will be distributed through the volunteer aid workers.
- ICRC distributed 8,500 tarpaulin sheets to vulnerable IDPs who have been recently displaced in the Kilinochchi and Mullaitivu districts. Of this total, 7,000 sheets were distributed in Karachchi and Kandawalai divisions in Kilinochchi District, with the rest going to PTK division in Mullaitivu district. The ICRC also distributed 2,000 emergency and hygiene kits during the same period.

TRINCOMALEE DISTRICT

Situation update

- The overall security situation in Trincomalee District was relatively stable, although with a number of incidents reported on the outskirts of Trincomalee town and areas bordering Mullaittivu and Welioya.
- Security forces remain on high alert and conduct cordon and search operations particularly in Trincomalee town and surrounding areas.

Displacement/Returns

- On 29 October, 47 families (143 individuals) returned to Chenaiyoor GN divisions in Muttur East from the Kiliveddy IDP transit site and on 30 October 61 families (204 individuals) returned to Chenaiyoor, Paddalipuram, Nalloor and Kaddaiparichchan South GN divisions from Batticaloa district.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- People in Need (PIN) completed an assessment for the reconstruction of 25 partly-damaged houses in Chenaiyoor.
- Oxfam is finalizing water trucking activities to IDP locations and return areas in the district on 31 October, which will leave a gap in water supply in some returnee locations.

BATTICALOA DISTRICT

Situation Update

- Several security incidents were reported during the period including attacks on security forces, police and TMVP.
- On 26 October, the TMVP organized a demonstration in Batticaloa protesting Indian involvement in Sri Lanka.

Displacement/Returns

- Government statistics of 28 October 2008 indicate the number of IDPs in the district to be 10,859 persons (2,861 families).
- On 23 October, the GoSL resettled 46 families (142 individuals) to Chenaiyoor in Trincomalee district. The movement was preceded by a UNHCR facilitated "Go & See" visit and information brochures as well as a certification of mine clearance.
- On 24 October, a "Go & See" visit was organized by the Government for 20 IDPs from Perillavely in Kiran DS division and was accompanied by UNHCR. The return movement for some 1,500 IDPs is tentatively scheduled for 11 November. In preparation, UNHCR provided jungle clearing tools to the IDPs on 30 October.
- GoSL organized another return movement to Chenaiyoor, Muthur on 30 October where 61 families (204 individuals) were expected to be resettled. Sixty families (190 individuals) are expected to be resettled during this movement, which will be preceded by a UNHCR facilitated "Go & See" visit, certified mine clearance and information leaflets.

Sector Development/Gaps

- WFP distributed 70,289 MT of mixed food commodities for 6,075 individuals comprising resettled persons and IDPs living in camps and with host families.
- The Valaichenai Pradeshiya Saba has been supplying 35,000 liters of drinking water to resettled villages in Vadamunai, Uthuchenai, Muruthanai, Poolakadu, Thikilivettai and part of Koravelly GN in Kiran with UNICEF support since 23 September 2008.
- With UNICEF support, 45 dug wells have been cleaned in Thikilivettai and Koravelly GN divisions (resettled divisions) in Kiran DS division.
- With the participation of UNICEF, UNOPS and IOM, UNHCR organized an inter-agency needs assessment to recently returned areas in Veppavaduwan and Periyapullumulai. On 30 November, the four agencies assessed the reintegration needs in the protection, shelter, watsan, health, livelihood and infrastructure sectors.
- UNHCR and partner agencies continued consultations with IDPs and local authorities on the consolidation of the 17 remaining IDP camps. Several camps now have limited numbers, while other camps are located in flood risk areas, or in insecure areas. Agreement has been reached with authorities and IDPs that Sinna Urani and Navatkerny camp inhabitants will transfer to Kokuvil camp, tentatively scheduled for 3 November. NRC and UNHCR will provide assistance to the affected IDPs. Discussions regarding other camps are ongoing.
- Shelter assistance to returned IDPs is ongoing in Veppavaduwan (IOM), Periyapullumulai (ICRC), and Koravelly (NRC/HELP).
- CHA's monthly Operational Meeting held on 30 October with the District Resettlement Coordinator, local NGOs, Inter-religious committee members, CBOs, CBSM members etc. discussed agencies' activities as well as challenges related to security situation.

- A UN mission consisting of staff from UNDP, the UN Resident Coordinator's Office and UNOCHA was in Batticaloa for 2 days to assess early recovery activities, livelihood coordination, joint UN interventions etc. The team had meetings with the GA and Planning Director, during which the GA stressed the need for additional support in the areas of agriculture, fisheries, and infrastructure sectors. Discussions were also held with the UN district team, CHA and the local NGO consortium etc.
- In 30 identified villages (in resettlement areas) in Kiran, Paddipalai, Vellavelly, Vavunatheevu DS divisions, a group of 24 performers conducted drama, theater and recreational activities through children's clubs. The activities ended on 25 October 2008.
- In Kiran resettled areas, a need for the support of small businesses (mainly retail shops) and community infrastructure including community buildings, irrigation channels, roads etc was highlighted at the Livelihood Coordination Meeting held on 30 October. Further, the issue of inadequate public transportation was noted.
- UNHCR/Solidar is conducting training on organic farming and peace building in Periya Pullumalai and Poolavelly in Chenkalady DS division for Tamil and Sinhala communities.
- SCiSL has completed its business development services training for 420 beneficiaries in 12 GN divisions to initiate income generating activities. A total of 23 trainings were conducted in all the 12 GN divisions.

AMPARA DISTRICT

Situation update

- The security situation in Ampara is generally stable, however with increasing reports of disappearances since July.
- The Kanchikudichiaru area remains tense and volatile due to ongoing military activity.
