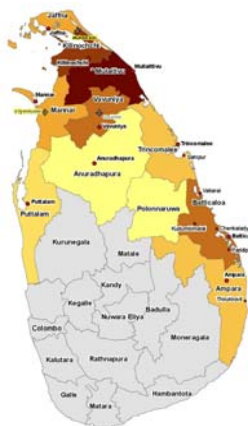


SITUATION REPORT # 155

JAFFNA DISTRICT

**Situation update**

- The security situation remained tense across the District. Artillery shelling continues.
- Several coastal villages and areas near the lagoon were flooded and several thousand people displaced from their homes and moved to schools, common building and friends' / relatives' homes. Rains slowed and flood waters receded at the end of week and most of those displaced were able returned to their homes. Currently, some families from lowland area remain in temporary camps. The Government, support by UN and NGO quickly responded to the flood emergency, with the situation now normalizing.
- Paddy fields and agricultural plots were flooded and large amounts of high land crops and fruit bearing trees were also destroyed. Thousands of houses were damaged or destroyed. The electricity supply was not functioning for three days but has now been restored. Telephone lines were out for several days. The government, supported by the humanitarian community is addressing water and sanitation issues as well as providing assistance to vulnerable persons.
- The prevailing bad weather intermittently interrupted mobile phone and internet coverage for most UN agencies. The Peninsula has limited access to land phone lines and internet services.

**Displacement>Returns**

- On 30 November, the Disaster Management Unit - Jaffna reported that 93,404 families (321,138 persons) were affected by floods and 25,862 families (94,965 persons) had move to 336 camps. Most of these camps have now been closed, and the remaining displaced expected to be able to return to their homes soon.
- Additional IDPs from the Vanni arrived in Jaffna district, increasing the total number of arrivals to 132 persons. IDP are being accommodated in the old court house.

**Sector Developments/Gaps**

- Since the capture of Pooneryn, the Government has relaxed restrictions on fishing distances and times.
- UN agencies / INGOs and NGOs are in the process of distributing NFRIs packages to 9,000 most vulnerable families affected by the floods.
- RDHS will give priority to cleaning wells at GCE O' Level examination centers this December.
- Flooding affected minefield areas, which resulted in the temporally suspended of de-mining activities.

## KILINNOCHCHI & MULLAITIVU DISTRICTS

### Situation update

- The situation in the Vanni continues to be tense, with reports of aerial bombardment near the Ulavanoor IDP settlement in Kallaru, Kandawalai AGA division and shelling in Vaddakkachchi village and near Paranthan, Kilinochchi.

### Internally Displaced Persons

- Nearly 120 IDP families who were taking shelter in the Ulavanoor area reportedly have fled after aerial bombardment on 29 November

### Sector Developments/Gaps

- Heavy rain continues to impact IDPs and residents in the Vanni. GA-Kilinochchi reports that approximately 45,000 families were affected by floods, 23,000 families displaced, with 6,064 families temporarily accommodated in schools and welfare centers. GA Mullaitivu reports that 21,200 families from Puthukkudiyiruppu, Maritimpeattu and Oddusuddan AGA divisions have been affected by the recent floods. An estimated 6,000 temporary shelters and 1,000 houses were destroyed or damaged in the Mullaitivu District. In the Kilinochchi District 13,382 temporary shelters were destroyed and 8,391 partially damaged during the floods. GA-Kilinochchi reports 2,888 houses destroyed and 2,385 partially damaged in Kilinochchi District due to the storm.
- A large number of the IDPs sites have been affected by the heavy rains in both districts. The state of water and sanitation facilities and the increased possibility of disease in IDP sites as well as some residential area is of concern to the people living there.
- On 01 December, 48 lorry loads of food (591.7 MT) and other materials donated by the Indian government were brought in a GA-Kilinochchi convoy from Vavuniya. Distribution is ongoing through MPCSSs to the IDPs.
- The UN Humanitarian Convoy planned for 01 December had to be postponed due to various delays including capacity constraints for clearing vehicles and security concerns. It went on 9 December.
- Zonal Directors of Education in the Vanni are making arrangements for the island-wide GCE [O/L] examination that will commence on 08 December. A total of 4,263 candidates from Mullaitivu and 5,116 from Kilinochchi are due to sit for the exam. Due to ongoing confrontations in some areas, two centers from Vaddakkachchi and Murasumoddai have been moved to new locations in Kilinochchi, while 4 centers have been moved in Mullaitivu. In order to accommodate 464 Vavuniya North students, 4 centers have been organized at Katchilaimadu village in Mullaitivu district by the department of education.
- The flood victims, who had been sheltered in the schools where GCE [O/L] examination centers have been established, were asked to vacate before 05 December in order for examinations to commence. In Kilinochchi district, IDPs have vacated all 19 schools to be used as examination centers. In Mullaitivu, the Department of Education with the help of the District Secretariat is preparing to vacate IDPs from 7 schools before 05 December.

## MANNAR & VAVUNIYA DISTRICTS

### Situation update

- The general situation in Vavuniya and Mannar District remains tense. Security forces remain on high alert across both districts, with regular cordon and search operations conducted.
- The Omanthai entry / exit point was closed for civilian traffic during the reporting period. However, urgent patient transfers and humanitarian convoys are being facilitated by the ICRC.
- Since 21 November, small numbers of people have started arriving from the Vanni to government controlled areas through Omanthai entry / exit point where they are registered and taken to a school and a community hall in the Manik Farm area. A total of 335 IDPs (138 families) are accommodated at these two locations, where assistance is being provided mainly by the Government.
- GA Mannar reports that 6,975 families (29,916 individuals) and 900 acres of paddy land were affected due to the recent floods in Mannar.

### Displacement>Returns

- 33 IDPs (15 families) accommodated at the Omanthai Maha Vidiyalaya are to be transferred to the Nellukkulam old welfare center.

### Sector Developments/Gaps

- Humanitarian Organizations are facing difficulty completing their projects before the end of this year, at least partially due to restriction on transportation of construction materials. For example, UNDP is waiting for approval to transport 11,000 bags of cement to Mannar needed to complete their shelter program by the end of the year.
- UNICEF facilitated the Vavuniya WASH coordination meeting on 02 December. Discussions focused on newly arrived IDPs who are accommodated at Manik Farm. Immediate needs for the site include latrines, bathing facilities and redirection of rain water. The Government has indicated it will address the drainage issue. Discussion are ongoing discussions between the Government and humanitarian organizations on assistance support and protection concerns.
- The WASH coordination meeting of 02 December highlighted issues at the Kallimodai and Sirukandal IDP camps including problems with irregular gully sucking activities, and a lack of screenings (privacy) for toilets in Kallimodai and the need for an additional seven latrines and a new water distribution network for Sirukandal camp.
- The Mannar District Disaster Management Centre is waiting for clearance to transport 100 tarpaulins from UNICEF Vavuniya office to Mannar to assist flood-affected families in the area.
- MOH Cheddikulam and Base Hospital -Cheddikulam made two mobile clinic visits to address health needs of the 335 displaced individuals in Menic Farm displaced from Vavuniya North.
- FOSDOO, the NGO Consortium and UNICEF agreed to support displaced O/Level students sitting for the examination on 8 December.

### TRINCOMALEE DISTRICT

#### Situation update

- The security situation in the district was relatively stable, although security forces continue to conduct daily cordon and search operations, especially in Trincomalee town.
- Trincomalee District experienced minimum rain fall during the reporting week enabling the previous week's flood-affected to recover. Ferry operations at Yanoya and Padavaikattu in Kuchchaveli DS Division, which were interrupted due to heavy rainfall last week, were fully functioning by 04 December.
- On 02 December, the GA held a Progress Review Meeting for the DSs, ADA, UN agencies and I/NGOs, where the progress, challenges and gaps were presented by the Sector/Cluster. Additionally, the GA encouraged better information flows between the DSs. UN agencies requested clarification on Government Plans and inputs for 2009 to maximize inputs from the UN / NGO, which are expected to have lower levels of resources available for 2009.
- On 30 November, a UXO was found in Senaiyoor by a Community Trust Fund, which was referred to the District Mine Action office.

#### Sector Developments/Gaps

- The Trincomalee General Hospital doctors and nursing staff went on strike since 01 December over 4 months arrears in overtime and holiday payment, despite other hospital staff in the district having received payments. The strike has resulted in reduced hospital services, impacting vulnerable patients, many of whom have traveled significant distances for care.
- A Child Friendly School exchange visit was organized by the Trincomalee Zonal Education Office to the Puttalam Education Zone. Eighty children accompanied by 10 parents and 15 teachers visited Child Friendly Schools and shared experiences.
- UNICEF initiated a school assessment in resettlement areas to review possibilities for UNICEF support, (no's of children going to school, teacher training needs, etc.) and to provide information to the ZDE/PDE on other unmet needs in the resettlement area, particularly related to teacher deployment, infrastructure needs.
- On 29 and 30 December, SCiSL organized a workshop on emergency response and child rights for 30 Grama Niladhari, Samurdhi Officers and Teachers of Muttur DS.
- UNICEF through the local NGO Coordinating Center for Community Development (3CD) provided 5,000 liters of drinking water daily to 78 families in Peruveli IDP transit site. The project came to an end on 30 November 2008.
- UNICEF, National Water Supply and Drainage Board, Divisional Secretary and the Pradeshiya Saba held a meeting to plan for the Water Supply Scheme at Kavanthisapur in Padavi Sripura. The project, funded by UNICEF and implemented through the NWS&DB Trincomalee aims to provide access to safe drinking water for approximately 250 families. The project will be implemented in close collaboration with the Divisional Secretary and Pradeshiya Saba Padavi Sripura and with involvement of community members.

### BATTICALOA DISTRICT

#### Situation Update

- Tensions in Batticaloa district have risen considerably in the recent weeks. The security situation remains unpredictable with an increased number of security incidents and killings.

- On 27 November, an NRC shelter staff member was killed in Batticaloa. Unidentified men entered the man's home and forcibly took him to a nearby decommissioned IDP-site, where they shot him. The UN Humanitarian Coordinator issued a statement on 3 December condemning the killing, which was the third killing or disappearance of an NRC staff member in Sri Lanka in the past two and half years.
- On 29 December, Batticaloa police imposed a curfew in the district from 0600 - 1800 hours and higher levels of alertness are being maintained by the Security Forces and Police. Daily joint search operations of SLA, STF and Police are being conducted in residential areas and IDP sites.

### Displacement>Returns

- According to Government statistics of 18 November 2008, there were 8,543 internally displaced persons (2,274 displaced families) in the district. Among them, 3,272 persons (947 families) are from Trincomalee District.

### Sector Development/Gaps

- The Valaichenai Pradeshya Shaba (PS) with UNICEF support supplied 45,000 liters of drinking water this week to Poolakadu, Thikilivettai and Pondugalchenai GN Division in Kiran DS Division. About 3,000 people benefit.
- 1,234 resettled persons in Perillavelly in Kiran DS division received six week's rations from WFP as there is no access to take the food to this area during the rainy season. 1,950 IDPs residing in the camps and 2,086 resettled persons obtained their 2 week rations.
