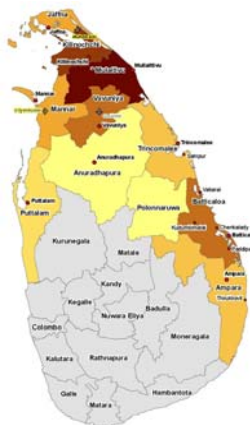

JAFFNA DISTRICT

Situation update

- Jaffna district continues to recover from Cyclone “Nisha” which struck on 26 November. Electricity and telecommunication have been restored in most divisions; roads have now been cleared and repaired. During the height of the emergency, many flood affected families found refuge in common buildings such as schools and temples. However during the reporting period most of the displaced families have been able to return to their homes. Government units as well as NGOs and UN agencies distributed relief items to the most affected and most vulnerable families. In addition, to other NFRIs, tarpaulin sheets were distributed by the shelter agencies, coordinated by the Shelter Cell. With a subsequent storm warning issued on 8 December, preparedness efforts were intensified.
- Rapid assessments conducted by agencies revealed that the actual number of persons displaced was lower than the initially published figures and that across the district only a few displacement sites remain.
- Government and humanitarian agencies are currently coordinating efforts to address water and sanitation issues in the aftermath of the floods, especially the cleaning of wells and drainage canals.
- The cyclone also affected the Kankesanthurai harbour which resulted in delays of off loading commodities.
- In addition, damage was caused to highland crops and fruit bearing trees resulting in vegetable and fruit price increase.
- In the reporting period, artillery shelling continued both day and night at the FDL in the Muhamalai area. The curfew remains in place from 21:00 to 4:30 am.

Displacement>Returns

- As of 8 December, 155 persons have arrived in Jaffna from the Vanni. On 6 December they were moved to the Kopay Teachers Training College, where basic needs are being addressed.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- Nearly 10,000 families have benefited from the NFR distribution by UN Agencies and NGOs. Stocks have been depleted and need to be replenished after the flood response.

- WFP plans to provide food aid to the 155 newly arrived IDPs from the Vanni, in December 2008. The food ration includes 400 g of cereals, 60 g of pulses, 20 g of oil and 20 g of sugar per person per day.
- Shipment MV "Ruhuru 29" arrived in Jaffna on 4 December 2008, with WFP commodities of 1,500 mt of rice, 200 mt of dhal, 250 mt of oil, 150 mt of sugar, 150 mt of CSB and 30 mt canned fish. This consignment covers needs of 120,000 IDPs and economically affected populations; and 46,000 pregnant, lactating women and small children in December 2008. The offloading of WFP cargo is underway at Kankasanturai Port.
- The RDHS reports that as many as 100,000 wells could be contaminated by flood water. UNICEF has provided 500,000 tablets to be distributed by the RDHS. However, quantities are insufficient to cover the total requirement. Agencies active in the WASH Cluster are providing support for cleaning of public wells.
- FAO has reported flood damage to their Stores, including 400 packs of vegetables seeds that have been water-logged.

KILINOCCHI & MULLAITHIVU DISTRICTS

Situation update

- Following hostilities in the Alampil and Semmalai areas in Mullaitivu district; the general security situation is tense in Mullaitivu town and surroundings. Artillery shelling was also reported in Silawaththai and Mullaiyavalai areas. According to the local media, Mulliyavalai Vidyanandha College was damaged by shelling.
- Seasonal rains started again in the Vanni region, with particularly negative impacts on displacement sites already affected by floods and cyclone, and where temporary shelters have not been rehabilitated since the rains started.
- Public/individual transportation has become a challenge as roads have been damaged by floods in Kilinochchi and Mullaitivu districts, mainly along the A-35 road.

Internally Displaced Persons

- New displacements are taking place from areas of Poothanvayal, Murippu, Kanukkerny, Maamulai, Alampil and Mulliyavalai in Mullaitivu district as the SLA advances on Alampil village. The majority of the displaced people have been moving west towards Puthukkudiyiruppu. Due to the ongoing registration, no confirmed figures are available yet.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- GA-Kilinochchi is waiting for approval from the MoD to transport fertilizers for paddy crops for the 'Maha' season that started one and a half month ago. GA has received permission for 3723.8 Mt of Urea, 1255.29 Mt of TSP and 1042.61 Mt of MOP from CGES last month.
- Due to the flooding that affected agriculture crops in the Vanni combined with the continued impacts of displacement, vegetable prices have increased significantly as illustrated in the following table:

- The fuel allocation from August to December 2008 for the health institutions of Kilinochchi district, is pending approval. The RDHS office presently awaits the transport of the earlier approved quantity of 2000 liters, since September 2008.

MANNAR & VAVUNIYA DISTRICTS

Situation update

- The general situation in Vavuniya and Mannar District remains tense. Security forces remain on high alert across both districts, with regular cordon and search operations conducted.
- The Omanthai entry / exit point was closed for civilian traffic during the reporting period. However, urgent patient transfers and humanitarian convoys are being facilitated by the ICRC.
- Since 21 November, small numbers of people have started arriving from the Vanni to government controlled areas through Omanthai entry / exit point where they are registered and taken to a school and a community hall in the Menik Farm area and Nellukkulam IDP sites. A total of 412 IDPs (174 families) are accommodated at these two locations with the majority of them at Menik Farm site. Assistance is being provided mainly by the Government.

Displacement>Returns

- 35 IDPs (17 families) newly arrived IDPs are being accommodated at the Nellukkulam old welfare center.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- Food convoy no 7 led by the UN, reached the Vanni on 9th December 2008 carrying 592 MT mixed food (Rice - 45MT, Wheat flour – 280 MT, Pulses- 187MT, Sugar- 60 MT, Oil – 20 MT). the convoy consisted of 40 trucks of food and 10 trucks of hygienic and educational items (bed sheet - 10000 Nos, Bacteriological H2S water quality testing kit – 500 Nos, Clothes for children -13000 Nos, Basin - Plastic 20 L capacity – 4000 Nos, Secondary school kit – 500 Nos, Black board 5x4 – 90 Nos, Expectant mother kits – 500 Nos, Recreation kit 175 Nos, Teacher kit – 872 Nos, Hygiene kit – 1200 Nos, Emergency health kits – 20 Nos, Infants kits – 300 Nos , Impregnated mosquito nets, adult -1900) to Wane. In addition, on 6 December 2008, the GA Convoy transported a total 63.584 MT mixed food to the Vanni (wheat Flour -19.15 MT, Milk Food - 7.05 MT, Oil- 8.55 MT to Kilinochchi and Sugar 8.375 MT, Milk Food 20.459 MT to Mullaitivu).
- Approval is currently awaited to transport urgently needed Shelter materials.
- At the request of the GA Mannar, Solidar and DRC distributed basic NFRI and hygienic materials to 157 IDPs families (377 individuals) who have arrived recently at Menik farm site.
- On 6 December, Education Day was celebrated in Vavuniya North with the participation of teachers, parents, students and Education Authorities. Prizes for outstanding students were awarded and Drama and Dance presentations made. The GA Vavuniya participated in the event.
- UNICEF in coordination with SCiSL, initiated a follow up session on assisting the students in Kalimoddai and Sirukundal IDP sites to gain new school admissions to Grade One in 2009, and for Grade 5 and Grade 11 students, to seek admission into new schools.
- 15 O/level IDP students who are currently accommodated in Menik farm, were able to sit for the examination in Schools in Vavuniya South.
- Hygiene promoters of Vavuniya DS division who are trained on WASH assessment techniques, visited 3,500 households (out of the targeted 25,000), with support from UNICEF. However, the prevailing heavy rains affected house-to-house visits during this week.
- The Child Protection Forum and UNICEF Protection Team held a follow-up session of the July 2008 1612 workshop conducted for Mannar Child Protection Stakeholders.
- On 4 December, the bi-weekly meeting of the Child Protection Subcommittee for Emergency was held at the Kachcheri, Vavuniya, facilitated by the UNICEF protection team.

TRINCOMALEE DISTRICT

Situation update

- The security situation in the district was relatively stable, although security forces continue to conduct daily cordon and search operations, especially in Trincomalee town.
- Heavy rains and strong winds were experienced on 7 December when a tropical storm approached the Trincomalee district. There were no reports of damage or people affected by the inclement weather.

Displacement>Returns

- On 5 December 27 families (63 persons) returned to Kaddaiparichan North while 6 families (19 persons) returned to Paddalipuram. One person also returned to Veeramanagar during the reporting period. In addition, on 6 December, 8 families (20 persons) returned from the Killiveddi camps to Paddalipuram.

Sector Developments/Gaps

- With OCHA's support, on 3 December Solidar ASB organized a meeting on capacity building of CBOs. Conclusions of the meeting were shared during the Livelihood meeting on 5 December where it was decided to have capacity building of CBOs, as a standard item on the agenda.
- A considerable gap in delivery of complementary food to IDPs, was reported at the 5 December Food Security meeting. WFP highlighted Food for Work opportunities to be integrated into UN or I/NGO activities in 2009.
- On a visit to the Trincomalee district during 9 – 12 December, UNICEF Country Representative met with various organizations and handed over 43 Mo-peds for use by Public Health Mid Wives (PHMs) at the RDHS office. The mo-peds aim to increase PHM coverage to an additional 120,000 families in 6 MOH Areas

BATTICALOA DISTRICT**Situation Update**

- A high level of alertness is being maintained by the security forces across the district with joint search operations of SLA, STF and Police being frequently conducted. The general situation in the district remains tensed with five significant security incidents reported in the district. However, the number of incidents is considerably lower than in the previous week.

Displacement/Returns

- According to Government statistics as of 18 November 2008, there are 8,543 internally displaced persons (2,274 families) in the district. This figure includes 3272 persons (947 families) from Trincomalee District.
- The Government is presently organizing a return movement within Batticaloa: On Friday 12 December, 40 IDP families currently displaced in Vinayagapuram, Valachchenai with host families will return to Vadamunai and Uththuchenai in Kiran DS division.

Sector Development/Gaps

- National Water Supply & Drainage Board (NWSDB) with UNICEF support identified 17 locations through the hydro-geological survey for drilling deep tube-well bore holes at Kiran resettlement villages. Borehole drilling started on 09 December at Koolavady village.
- UNICEF supported the RDHS on the construction of 3 Gramodaya Health Centres, which will be ready before the end of December. These GHCs are located at Periyaporathivu, Arasaditivu & Vavunathivu and are expected to address the current health access problems of children & mothers in these resettled villages.
- UNICEF supported construction of the "Maternal Ward Complex" and an 'On Call Duty Room' at Central Dispensary in Palugamam; which will be ready for use from January 2009.
- The Valaichenai Pradeshya Shaba (PS) with UNICEF support supplied 45,000 liters of drinking water this week to Poolakadu, Thikilivettai and Pondugalchenai GN Division in Kiran DS Division. About 3,000 people are expected to benefit from this project.
