- Pilot training 18-22 August 2008, The Hague

- Based on UN Disaster Assessment and Coordination (UNDAC) training methodology
- Modular approach
- Safety and security, information management, media training, stress management, HIT, FEAT, EAM, etc.
- Evaluation
