SECURITY

PLAN FOR Man-made & Natural Disaster



PURPOSE:

To ensure safety and security of UN staff and dependants during and after evacuation exercises.

HISTORICAL EVENTS

- Storm and Flood
- Political Crises
- Religious Crises
- Communal Clashes

WARNING SIGNS

- Admission and detection in the hospital of a reasonable number of patients with symptoms of any of the Influenzas.
- Declaration of State of Emergency in any State of the Federation

PANDEMIC LEVEL

- Uncontrollable outbreak of Swine Flu
- Uncontrollable outbreak of Avian Flu
- Uncontrollable Political, Ethnic or Religious crises

SUPPORT TO HUMANITARIAN INTERVENTION

- Assist in Security Clearances
- Security Escorts and Backup
- Liaison/External Police Assistance
- Security of Materials & Equipment

LIKELY SECURITY INCIDENTS

- Attack by hoodlums on evacuees
- Blockage of routes of evacuation
- Sudden illness and collapse of evacuees
- Forced request for assistance/siege by non-UN Staff members

MITIGATION MEASURES

A. ROUTES/MEANS

- Routes by road should be identified
- Alternate routes identified and marked
- Evacuation by air should be explored
- Vehicles and airlines arranged

B. PHYSICAL PROTECTION

- ✓ Prior request/arrangement for police protection at concentration points
- ✓ Prior request/arrangement with law enforcement agents along the routes

COMMUNICATIONS

Orientation on and use of communication gadgets:

- VHF
- HF
- Mobile Internet

Use of Sathphones

Use of GSM lines

BACK UP RESOURCES

Nigeria Police (MOPOL) contingents
attached to the UN act as security
back-up

UN Vehicles with drivers act as back-up
for conveyance
