

SHELTER/ NFI CLUSTER

El Nino Preparedness, October, 2009

The NFI/ Shelter Cluster Flood Preparedness Plan is based on the most likely scenario of Somalia in October - December 2009. It is based on the 2006 flooding, which looked at 300,000 displaced people. The agencies will work closely with other clusters.

The Shelter Cluster interventions are divided into three categories:

- o Emergency assistance for the newly displaced
- o Transitional solutions for the improvement of the living conditions for the protracted displaced
- o Provision of durable solutions for the early recovery of the displaced.

The update on the stock levels and items in the pipeline has been requested from the cluster members in order to identify the planned activities and stocks in the pipeline in the six regions that are likely to be affected by the flood.

Planning Assumptions:

- Respond to the flood affected region, considering NFI/ temporary inputs from the cluster members
- Agreed Shelter/NFI cluster target of 330,000 IDPs as immediate flood planning figure with upper ceiling of 500,000
- Replenish standing field preparedness stocks utilized in flood response
